

The Four R's of Solid Waste

REDUCE – Buy only what you need, and use whatever you buy. Look for items with a minimum of packaging and with packaging that is recyclable.

REPAIR – Fix items that are broken rather than buy new ones. If you don't want to fix them, give them to someone who will.

REUSE – Look for reusable items rather than disposable ones. If you can no longer use something, find someone else who can, through donations, garage sales, classified ads, or resale shops.

RECYCLE – Create new items out of unwanted ones.

Why Recycle?

Because Recycling...
Reduces the amount of solid waste to landfill.
This saves tax dollars.
Promotes conservation of natural resources.
Reduces pollution and saves energy.

Close the Loop Buy Recycled Products

Look for products that state they are recycled. Even better, buy those that have post-consumer recycled contents.

Rules for Using the Rindge Transfer Station

This facility is open to all Rindge residents, non-resident property owners and businesses.

Users of this facility must obtain a permit sticker from the Selectmen's Office and it must be displayed on the driver's side rear window of the vehicle. Vehicles without stickers will not be permitted to use the facility.

The Town of Rindge implemented **Mandatory Recycling** on September 1, 1992. All users of this facility must separate and deposit in the appropriate areas the items listed on the back.

Hazardous waste items are not accepted and will be refused. Please save these items for the annual Household Hazardous Waste Day.

HOW TO RECYCLE

MIX BIN #1

Glass (any color)	Glass jars and bottles. No plate or window glass mirrors, light bulbs or ceramics.	Remove lids, rinse out.....No Fee Labels are okay.
Aluminum, Tin & Steel Cans	Beverage cans such as beer, soda and juice, dog and cat food cans.	Rinse out. Do not crush.....No Fee
Plastic Containers (any color)	Milk, windshield washer fluid, shampoo, laundry detergent, flower pots. No motor oils or antifreeze.	Rinse out. Labels are okay.....No Fee Remove tops. Okay to flatten milk.

MIX BIN #2

Paper, Card Stock	All newsprint, magazines, glossy inserts, junk mail, shredded paper, cereal, shoe or detergent boxes	Keep dry, bag or bundle.....No Fee

CARDBOARD BIN

Cardboard	Double-walled, corrugated.	Keep dry, clean and flatten out..... No Fee

OTHER

Scrap Metal	Small items to include white goods	See attendants.....Fee on Some Items
Motor Oil	Up to 50-weight oil. (No gasoline)	One-gallon clear containers.....No Fee See attendants.
Latex Paint	No oil base	See attendants.....No Fee
Furniture	Anything that will not fit in the compactor	See attendants.....Fee Applied
Wet Cell Batteries	From cars, trucks, boats, etc	Keep upright.....Fee Applied
Tires	Auto, truck, motorcycle, bicycle	See attendants.....Fee Applied
Leaves & Grass Clippings	Minimal sticks, twigs, or branches	Empty from bags.....No Fee
Demolition Debris	Clean lumber, sheet rock, etc	See attendants.....Fee Applied
